Who is a LeaderLuncheon Honoree?

A LeaderLuncheon Honoree is an established woman in her mid-to-late career, who has made a commitment to and a significant difference in her community and world. Her achievements demonstrate vision, creativity, and initiative.

For example, she may have:

- Achieved outstanding success in her chosen field
- Broken new ground, overcome barriers, or been an agent for change
- Participated actively as a volunteer
- Served as a leader and as a positive role model
- Provided significant mentorship to girls and/or women

2024 LeaderLuncheon Nomination Guidelines

Nominee Criteria

- The nominee must be a woman, or identify as a woman, living on the island of Oʻahu, Hawaiʻi at the time of the nomination
- The nominee must be available for filming, date to be determined
- The nominee must be available for the LeaderLuncheon event May 9, 2024
- The nominee must not be a current member of YWCA Oahu's Board of Directors
- The nominee cannot be currently running for a public office

Selection Criteria

- Honorees must embody YWCA Oahu's mission of eliminating racism and empowering women
- · Honorees are in the mid-to-late stage of her career
- Honorees are role models, leaders, and advocates for the advancement of women and girls
- Honorees will be sought from all industries and sectors

Selection Process

- All selection committee members will review the completed nomination packages prior to the selection committee meeting
- Finalists are based on the strength of the application and alignment with YWCA O'ahu mission and values
- All deliberations of the selection committee will be treated confidentially
- Selection of Honorees will be final
- Nominators will be notified after the selection committee meeting regarding the status of their candidate application
